1. 1. REPERTORIOS BIBLIOGRÁFICOS GENERALES Y ESPECIALIZADOS

Para una actualización bibliográfica es primordial la consulta de una serie de revistas especializadas que acogen las novedades que año tras año se van produciendo. Entre las que destacan por sus repertorios bibliográficos cabe citar: *American Quarterly* y *American Studies International*, así como *Mississippi Quarterly*, *Modern Fiction Studies* y *African American Review*. Otros títulos de referencia importantes son:

- A Critical Bibliography of American Literature Studies*. Oxford: Blackwell Publishers, 1998. Recopilaciones fundamentales anuales que incluyen comentarios críticos a la bibliografía.
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Una de las colecciones más importantes dentro de este grupo es el *Dictionary of Literary Biography* (Detroit, Mich.: Gale Research Co., 1978-), con más de treinta volúmenes, que cubren la mayor parte de información referida a los Estados Unidos (por ejemplo, vol. 30, *American Historians, 1607-1865*, 1984; vol. 31, *American Colonial Writers, 1735-1781*, 1984). La serie también incluye a autores afroamericanos posteriores a 1955, en un volumen editado por Thadious M. Davis y Trudier Harries. También destaca la serie *Contemporary Authors: A Bio-Bibliographical Guide to Current Authors and Their Works* (Detroit, Mich.: Gale Research Co., 1967-). Otros títulos importantes son:
