
Preschool block

Tips for parents on how to use this block:

Cutting with scissors is an important fine motor skill that children should practise and fine-tune regularly. This block gives you the opportunity to help your child learning how to comfortably use scissors and glue. Make sure you buy **appropriate scissors** for your child (right-handed or left-handed).

Please do not expect your child to always cut exactly on the line. However, you should always encourage them to try. Support your child even if their first attempts are not so successful.


Your child will have a much easier time working with this block if you tear out the page your child wants to work with.


Many pages have objects or shapes to cut out at the top, bottom or sides of the pages. You can help your child by **generously cutting out individual parts** or strips, thus making the precision work easier for them.

You can also help your child with the more difficult tasks, such as fixing things together with a thread, poking small holes, etc.
Your child can cut out a lot of pictures in this block and label them on the reverse side. These pictures make great quick gifts for loved ones!







Rug pattern

Cut out the shapes at the top of the page and glue them where they belong on the rug. Then cut out your picture.










Lucky toadstool

This cheerful toadstool is missing some spots. Cut them out and glue them onto its cap. Then cut out your picture.








How to make a flag

Cut out the picture and fold it in the middle. You can also fold it first and then cut it out. Place a thin wooden stick in the fold and glue the flag firmly together.










Leaf puzzle

There is a piece missing from each puzzle. Cut out the puzzle pieces at the top of the page and glue them where they belong. Then cut out your picture.














Gift tag
