The way to a firm sleep rhythm
Even babies need different amounts of sleep at
<u>night</u>
The baby has yet to find its sleep rhythm
<u>Infants learn to calm themselves first</u>
Sleeping well takes time - endurance is required
<u>here</u>
Every now and then, parents need extra tuition
Good basis for soft and healthy baby sleep
<u>Infants need the experience of security and</u>
<u>reliability</u>
Everyday routine helps the baby to find a rhythm
<u>Just a tired baby likes to sleep too</u>
Prevent the baby from getting tired - otherwise it is
<u>difficult to fall asleep and relax</u>
<u>Increased screaming and howling is often a sign of</u>
<u>lack of sleep.</u>
<u>Independence during the day also supports at night</u>
<u>(rest)</u>
<u>Sleeping independently makes sleeping through</u>
easier for the baby
The appropriate sleeping environment is important for
<u>a soft baby sleep</u>
<u>Safe baby sleep - always in supine position</u>
Safe and secure stored in a cradle, bassinet or cot
Good equipment of the sleeping place - with
<u>sleeping bag but without pillow</u>
<u>Don't wear the baby too thickly for baby sleep - this</u>
is the best way to get a good night's sleep.
